THE OZ EXPERIENCE

(now in its 9th year)

In 2002 the Joshua Foundation launched the Oz Experience ... allowing young people to travel to Australia to engage in conservation projects under the auspices of CVA (Australia's largest conservation agency)

Teams travel out to Australia in groups of approx 20 -30, flying into various cities where they spend a few days enjoying local sights and events.

After a few days in the host city, the group moves out into the 'bush', the mountains or coastal nature reserves where they are involved in various conservation projects: Forestry work (tree planting), hydrology projects, or animal welfare programmes.

At the end of this week, they travel to Sydney where they enjoy a few days of leisure, including climbing the famous Harbour Bridge, a visit to the local oncology hospital for children, sight-seeing + shopping.

Each team member must raise a minimum sponsorship of £2800. To assist the individual + school teams, a regional schools coordinator will liaise with you over the period of fundraising.

Further support:

A parents evening will be held once the team is registered in each region, to enable parents + students to meet up and discuss fundraising strategies. In addition regional social events are often organized to bring team members together. Nearer the departure date, a final parents meeting will be held to meet up with team leaders and for the dissemination of travel information + uniform items are distributed.

Other Costs:

To secure a place on the 2012 trip, you will need to pay a £80 non-refundable registration fee (a total fee of £160 will cover admin + support costs) .. the second half of the fee is payable in February 2012 in addition the individual must cater for the following costs: Visa costs (£20), Insurance (£50), Bridge Climb (£100), Uniform (£40) ... plus UK transport costs to Heathrow Airport. We usually advise a maximum of £350 in personal spending money.

 Revisit by School Coordinator to meet with interested students.
 Students complete + submit an application form.
 On receipt of an offer letter.. send acceptance letter + first registration fee (£80).
 You will be sent a letter enabling you to log on to the web site ... to download full team pack.
 You will be visited regularly by your regional schools coordinator.

THE USA EXPERIENCE

In 2011 the Joshua Foundation launched a new overseas project, The "USA Experience"... allowing young people to travel to the USA to engage in conservation and restoration projects in New York City + New York State.

Teams travel out to the USA in groups of approx 20 -30, flying into New York City where they spend a few days enjoying local sights and events.

After a few days in the city, the group moves out into NY State where they engage in various projects including "Hole in the Wall Camps" (set up by Paul Newman) ... the world's largest family of camps for children with serious illnesses & life-threatening conditions. [www.holeinthewall.org]

Also possible involvement in restoration projects with Bette Midler's "New York restoration programmes [www.nyrp.org]

At the end of these projects, they travel back to New York City where they enjoy a few days of leisure, including addressing a challenge project working with one of the local children's oncology hospitals.

Each team member must raise a minimum sponsorship of £2000 To assist the individual + school teams, a regional schools co-ordinator will liaise with you over the period of fundraising. see web site: www.theusaexperience.co.uk
